

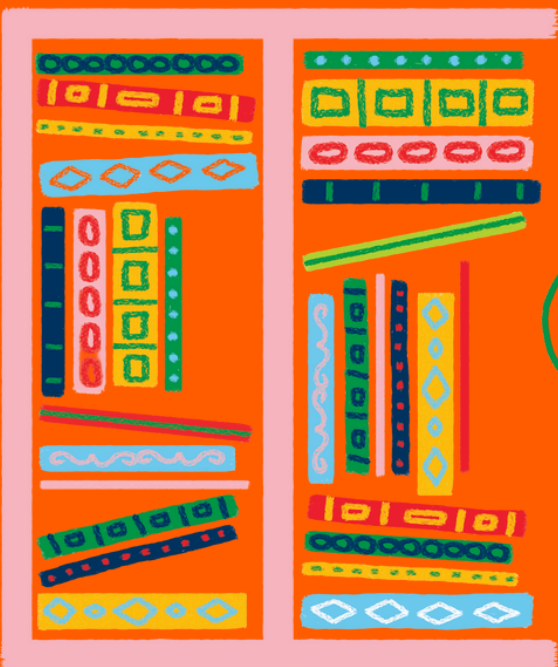
ACTIVITIES

- ★ Participate in a library program or activity
- ★ Step outside your comfort zone—read a type of book you don't normally read: nonfiction, graphic novel/manga, science fiction, fantasy, dystopian, humor, mystery, romance, horror, etc. (This counts toward reading log)
- ★ Play a board game, cards, chess, tabletop RPG, or outside game
- ★ Try one of our e-resources: Mango Languages, Libby, Hoopla, Kanopy, drivingTests.org, Learning Express Library. Ask a librarian for a demo
- ★ Do something outside or explore nature
- ★ Tell someone about a book you really like
- ★ Stop by the Library's teen department and wave at the librarians
- ★ Explore technology by making digital art, or exploring music, video, or podcast creation
- ★ Make art and leave it in the community
- ★ Try cooking a new recipe or a new dish at a restaurant
- ★ Make wearable art (clothes, jewelry, etc.)
- ★ Make some art with nature
- ★ Read or listen to a book that has won an award
- ★ Attend a library program or go to a community event
- ★ Read a book about an artist or musician (fiction or nonfiction)
- ★ View art in our community (try one of the Library's galleries, Spiva Center for the Arts, Local Color, public murals, or other museums in our area)
- ★ Make art using unique methods (use your non-dominant hand, paint blindfolded, or turn your art upside down every three minutes while you work)
- ★ Make a playlist inspired by your favorite book, movie, or artwork
- ★ Read outside
- ★ Suggest a book to someone else (fill out a suggestion form in the Teen Department)

Remember to log reading-related activities on your reading log! Audiobooks and graphic novels can count toward your reading totals!
