Makerspace at Joplin Public Library

The Joplin Public Library Makerspace is a place where people may create, explore, tinker, and discover using a variety of tools and materials. Use of Makerspace equipment is FREE, though makers must bring their own materials and a small cost-recovery fee applies to consumables.

Enjoy equipment such as a Laser Cutter, Digital Media Conversion, 3D Printers, upgraded PCs with a variety of software, a sewing machine, button press, Cricut and more.

A library card is NOT necessary to access the Makerspace, but JPL is excited to offer FREE Summer Reading library cards available to everyone regardless of where they live.

Our Makerspace Assistant, Jen, is back from maternity leave and with her return, we have more open hours in the space! Thank you to Justin (IT Manager) for covering the space in her absence!


MAKERSPACE HOURS

To participate:

- Pick up a FREE 12" x12" canvas from the library's Circulation, Children's, Reference, or Teen department desks
- Create artwork on the canvas! (Your completed artwork may not exceed 12" x 12" x 12".)
- Return your artwork to the library by 5pm on Sunday, June 29th to be included in the library-wide exhibition. (Late entries will not be accepted.)
- Save the date for YOUR opening reception (and bring your friends & family): Thursday, July 10th from 5:30-6:30pm
- Once the exhibit closes, pick your artwork up from the library!

It's that simple! During the exhibit, visitors will have the opportunity to vote for People's Choice in three different categories: Kids, Teen, and Adult, with winners being announce on Friday, August 15th.
